2 THE COURT: Can we have the jury, please.

3 (Jury in.)

4 THE COURT: All right. You may be seated.

5 You were on cross, Mr. Bynum.

6 MR. BYNUM: I was, Judge. At this time we have no
7 further questions for the witness.

8 THE COURT: Redirect?

9 MR. ASLETT: Very briefly, Judge.

10 SERGEANT M. BRADY,
11 having been duly sworn, testified as follows:

12 REDIRECT EXAMINATION

13 BY MR. ASLETT:

14 Q. Officer Brady, I neglected to ask you yesterday, did
15 you do any investigation into whether the defendant had ever
16 served in any branch of the Armed Forces?

17 A. I made a phone call to some contacts in San Diego
18 with the Marine department criminal investigation services,
19 something along that line, and asked them if they had any
20 record of him.

21 Q. And did you uncover any evidence that the defendant
22 had ever served in the military?

23 A. No, I did not.

24 Q. I want to just very briefly clear up some things that
25 defense counsel went into on his cross. I believe that Julie

1 gave something like five statements to the -- to HPD; is that
2 correct?

3 A. Yes.

4 Q. Okay.

5 A. Four or five.

6 Q. I guess the first one would be the recorded statement
7 that you and Officer Rohling took at the scene, right? And
8 correct me if I'm wrong in any of this. I'm just trying to
9 keep everything straight. You remember that, right?

10 A. Yes.

11 Q. Okay. And then I guess Julie goes that night to the
12 police station and gives another recorded statement to an
13 Officer Wilson?

14 A. That's correct.

15 Q. And were you present for that one?

16 A. No.

17 Q. Okay. And then there are I think two recorded
18 statements she gives to Officer Rohling on the phone; is that
19 right?

20 A. That could be.

21 Q. Okay. And were you present for either of those?

22 A. Not if he was talking to her on the phone by himself.

23 Q. Okay. And then I guess there's another one where you
24 go to talk to Julie about things that -- about your interview
25 with Coreena. I guess that's her last statement, right?

1 A. Yes.

2 Q. And was that statement also recorded?

3 A. Yes.

4 Q. Okay. And was the purpose of talking to her that
5 last time to talk to her about some things that Coreena had
6 said?

7 A. Yes.

8 Q. Okay. And during that final interview with Julie,
9 did Julie explain to you why Coreena had lied?

10 A. Yes.

11 Q. Okay. That the immigration stuff, the -- her
12 marijuana use in the apartment, and the child abandonment
13 stuff, that was all explained to you during that interview?

14 A. Yes.

15 Q. Okay. And those are all Coreena's issues, reasons
16 why Coreena was worried and had lied to you initially, correct?

17 A. I believe so, yes.

18 Q. Okay. And who was it that brought all of those
19 reasons that Coreena lied to your attention?

20 A. I believe Coreena called Sergeant Rohling and said
21 she wanted to clarify some of her statements, then we went back
22 the next day, which would I think be the third, and that's when
23 we talked to Coreena again and then I believe we talked to
24 Julie again, for the final time.

25 Q. Okay. So Julie told you that Coreena had lied. She

1 was up-front about that, right?

2 A. Right.

3 Q. And she has no control over that, does she, what
4 Coreena says, and Coreena's issues, right?

5 A. No.

6 Q. Okay. And I guess when you go back and talk to
7 Coreena, and I guess confront her, hey, we saw you on the
8 Fiesta video, what's up with that, why did you say you never
9 left your apartment, does she eventually fess up?

10 A. Yes.

11 Q. And does she explain to you and Sergeant Rohling
12 personally why she was concerned and why she lied the first
13 time?

14 A. Yes.

15 Q. Okay. And did this whole issue of Coreena not
16 wanting to be upfront that she left her child alone with her
17 brother in the apartment, does that have any real bearing to do
18 with this murder case?

19 A. No.

20 MR. ASLETT: Pass the witness, Judge.

21 MR. BYNUM: Briefly.

22 RECROSS-EXAMINATION

23 BY MR. BYNUM:

24 Q. You know, the -- Coreena wanted to clarify some
25 things and so she asked you to come back so she could clarify

1 things. That's what you just said, correct?

2 A. Yes, I believe that's true.

3 Q. The main thing she wanted to clarify in her later
4 statements was that she said before that Julie had gone to the
5 apartment twice?

6 A. Correct.

7 Q. And she wanted to tell you now that Julie didn't
8 actually do that, Julie just went to the apartment the one
9 time, and not the time before, right?

10 A. Correct.

11 Q. So what she wanted to clarify is that she wanted to
12 take Julie out of the scene of this crime at the time it
13 happened. That's what she wanted to clarify, right?

14 A. She wanted to clarify what had happened.

15 Q. Sure. So she had spoken with Julie about the
16 timeline that night, right?

17 A. She must have.

18 Q. And she wanted to let you know that what she told you
19 initially closest to the time it happened actually wasn't what
20 happened after she had talked to Julie about it, right?

21 A. Yes.

22 MR. BYNUM: Nothing further, Judge.

23 MR. ASLETT: Nothing further from the State, Judge.

24 THE COURT: Thank you so much for coming in.
