

1 THE COURT: Officer has been sworn.
2 You may proceed.

3 **K. M. COCKRILL,**
4 having been first duly sworn, testified as follows:

5 **DIRECT EXAMINATION**

6 BY MR. JONES:

7 Q. Officer Cockrill, how are you presently
8 employed?

9 A. With the Houston Police Department.

10 Q. Back on 10/12/11 how were you employed?

11 A. With the Houston Police Department.

12 Q. Did you participate in an investigation
13 involving a Travoy Hollie that day?

14 A. Yes, sir.

15 Q. Were there other persons connected with
16 that investigation of Mr. Hollie?

17 A. Yes, sir.

18 Q. Back on October the 12th, did you have
19 occasion to stop a vehicle to which he was an
20 occupant?

21 A. Yes, sir.

22 Q. And did you do an offense report?

23 A. I didn't write an offense report.

24 Q. So, did you stop the vehicle pursuant to
25 information you had that there had been a possible

1 assault and abduction?

2 A. That's correct, sir.

3 Q. And did you yourself observe an assault or
4 abduction?

5 A. I didn't.

6 Q. Did you issue any citations?

7 A. I didn't.

8 MR. JONES: I pass the witness.

9 MS. BARNETT: I don't have any
10 questions, Judge.

11 THE COURT: You may step down. Call
12 your next witness.

13 MR. JONES: Pardon me, Judge. Who is
14 the other officer?

15 THE WITNESS: Parkinson.

16 MR. JONES: I call Officer Parkinson.

17 THE COURT: Officer has been sworn.

18 TAVIS PARKINSON,

19 having been first duly sworn, testified as follows:

20 DIRECT EXAMINATION

21 BY MR. JONES:

22 Q. Officer Parkinson, would you state your
23 name, please?

24 A. Tavis Parkinson.

25 Q. How are you employed?
