    - A. Since 2010.

He's the sergeant that answers the phone and when the call came in, he informed me that there was a case that needed to be investigated, that day shift had already -- investigators had been called out and that they were asking for assistance.
  - Q. So the assignment basically was you were just up next in the rotation or was it --
  - A. I just volunteered. They just asked if anybody wanted to go, and I volunteered.
    - Q. Where did you go to?
- 17 A. I went to -- to the scene which was at 5430 Madden Lane.
  - Q. And when you arrived there, who did you talk to?

- A. Sergeant Meeler, when he was out at the scene, he had asked if I could -- if I could escort Mr. Abdelmotal to the Domino's Pizza because he may have a record of the complainant's route, his pizza route, and so we were going there to see if we could get that.
- Q. And when you arrived at the store, did the owner pull up information relevant to the complainant's delivery route?
  - A. Yes, ma'am.
  - Q. And were you able to view that?
  - A. Yes, ma'am.
- Q. Did -- did he provide any type of document that recorded the specific order that the complainant was delivering?
- A. Yes, ma'am. He had -- he got onto the computer there at the Domino's Pizza and he was -- he printed, I think it was, a single page of the complainant's last delivery.

1 Q. Okay. So a delivery summary basically? 2 Yes, ma'am. Α. 3 Okay. Did you view that document? Q. 4 Yes, ma'am. Α. 5 And after viewing that document, at some 0. 6 point did you write a supplement report? 7 Yes, ma'am. Α. 8 Q. And did you record in your supplement 9 report the information that was noted on that 10 document? 11 Yes, ma'am, I did.
